

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

LIHEAP provides help with heating costs to income-eligible households. This is a Federal Program administered in Maine by the Maine State Housing Authority and delivered in York County by York County Community Action Corporation.

You MUST make an appointment to apply.

Please follow these steps:

1. Schedule your LIHEAP appointment on-line at www.yccac.org. Just click the LIHEAP link on the YCCAC homepage and follow the prompts.

Or . . .

You can call the Energy program office in Sanford to schedule your appointment. Applications are taken at sites throughout York County, but if scheduling by phone you must make your LIHEAP appointment through the YCCAC office in Sanford (324-5762, Option 8). Home visits are available for homebound clients.

2. Bring **ALL** documentation listed below to your LIHEAP appointment. Your application **WILL NOT** be approved without these items. However, if you are missing documents, please still attend your appointment. You will be given additional days to bring in missing info.

Gross Income for all household members, including but not limited to:

- Wages
- Self-employment documentation
- Social Security/SSI/pension award letters (we cannot accept bank statements)
- TANF/child support verification
- Interest/dividend income
- General Assistance
- Notes of support from anyone who provided financial support to the household during the previous 3 or 12 months
- Most recent electric bill, showing kilowatt usage
- Date of birth and Social Security cards for each household member
- Name, address, and phone number of landlord (if applicable)
- Fuel account number (if applicable)
- Overdue bills
- Child support legal paperwork/divorce decree/court orders
- Leases required
- Valid Government ID of primary applicant

3. Please be considerate. If you are unable to make your appointment, call us so that we can reschedule you and offer your time to someone else.

Appointments will be accepted until April 30, 2016.

Homeowners or Renters who are at or below these income levels and have a household member over age 60 or under age 2 may be eligible for LIHEAP assistance.
