The story that caused quite a stir in Newfield 112 years ago will be told by Ruth Bridges Ayers at the Waterborough Historical Society’s meeting Thursday evening, June 7<sup>th</sup>. A house and barn burned during the night, and the bodies of four brutally murdered people were found in the remains – those of George Goodwin, a Civil War veteran, his adopted son, the housekeeper and hired man.
