## Society's Properties Update:

### Johnson Lumber Mill

Acquired through donation in 1976. Placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2007. This year we will continue raising money for the reset of the smoke stack and make plans to have the building open to the public.

### Carle's Corner Museum

#### Jane R. McGrath Memorial Library

Our current meeting place was acquired in 1979 through a 99 year lease from the Town. This years big project is to get the rest of the building painted, to continue creating displays and to organize the archives.

### Deering School House

Acquired through donation in 2007. This last untouched one room school in Waterboro was moved to the grounds of the Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House. A re-dedication of the restored school was held in 2011 with Deering family members participating.

### Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House

This 1850 historic home was acquired through a 99 year lease with the Town in 2008. It was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2004. Open 1-3 PM on Saturdays, May 26 thru Oct. 6.

Acquired in April 2010 through a donation. Recent work completed includes: new septic system, 2 bathrooms, new furnace and public water. Restoration continues. Placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2012.


