

**Waterboro's Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House Museum Re-opens for the Season
Saturday mornings 9am-12noon beginning May 18, 2013**



The 1850 **Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House Museum**, 6 Old Alfred Road at the intersection with Sokokis Trail, Waterboro Center, is an unspoiled dwelling with many original features. It will be open to the public free of charge, with donations appreciated, each Saturday morning, 9 to Noon, from May 18th through September 28th. The museum complex includes the period-furnished one-room 1817 Deering Schoolhouse and a blacksmith shop. The barn and ell of the house contain antique cobbler, optician, and barber shops. Concurrently, the Maine Farmers and Artisans Market will be held on museum grounds.
