The Waterborough Historical Society's Taylor House Farmer & Artisan Market is a non-profit organization.

The THFAM is a 'producer's market'.

- All products sold must be grown, raised, or produced, by the vendor within the state of Maine. No reselling of any item purchased from another source shall be permitted, with the exception of individually approved non-profit organization sales (ie: Girl Scout cookies, etc.).
Craft/artisan vendors may not sell commercially finished items. All vendors must adhere to the Maine Statute governing farmers markets.
- A 10' X 10' EZ-up, straight-leg canopy is required for all vendors. This serves a dual purpose; it creates a unified look at the market and protects vendors in case of inclement weather or hot sun. The THFAM is held rain or shine.

VENDOR FEE: Season: \$175. for one 10' X 10' space. A full season will consist of twenty (20) weeks

Part Time: \$10. per week for one 10' X 10' space
