

***The 1850 Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House Museum
Open 9am-12noon Saturdays***



The 1850 Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House Museum, 6 Old Alfred Road at the intersection with Sokokis Trail, Waterboro Center, is an unspoiled dwelling with many original features.

It will be open to the public free of charge, with donations appreciated, each Saturday morning, 9 AM to 12 Noon, through September 27th.

The museum complex includes the period-furnished one-room 1817 Deering Schoolhouse and a blacksmith shop. The barn and ell of the house contain antique cobbler, optician, and barber shops.
