The 1850 Taylor/Frey/Leavitt House Museum in Waterboro Center is an unspoiled dwelling with many original features. It is open to the public free of charge each Saturday from 1 to 3 pm (or by appointment) through Columbus Day Weekend. Added to the museum complex this year is the period-furnished one-room 1817 Deering Schoolhouse. The barn and ell of the house contain antique cobbler, optician, barber and blacksmith shops.
