The ride will begin and end at the Alfred Shaker Museum (118 Shaker Hill Road, Alfred). There are four different ride loops of varying distances: 100-miles, 62-miles, 35-miles, and 7-miles, covering 11 towns: Alfred, Sanford, Springvale, Acton, Newfield, Shapleigh, Limerick, Lyman, Limington, Hollis and Waterboro. *We are asking for your support to safely roll through your town, using the following roads:*

Ridership is limited to 350 registrants.
