

Maine Residents Property Tax and Rent Refund “Circuitbreaker” Application

(for refunds of property tax assessed or rent paid during 2011)

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A REFUND UP TO \$1,600 IF:

- You do not have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2011 household income was **\$64,950** or less; or
- You have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2011 household income was **\$86,600** or less
AND
 - Your 2011 property tax was more than 4% of your 2011 household income; or
 - The rent you paid in 2011 was more than 20% of your 2011 household income.

NOTE: Low-income Seniors do not need to meet these requirements.

Applications must be filed by May 31, 2013.
