

Town of Waterboro Absentee Ballots Available



Absentee Ballots for the November 8, 2011. Referendum Election is now available in the Town Clerk's office. People wishing to register to vote must do so in person and bring proof of their residency, i.e. Driver license, cable or power bill with current Waterboro physical address, **NOT** PO box. Request for a mailed ballot can be made in writing or by telephone by the voter. Emailed requests are also available through the State of Maine's website only.

If you are planning to vote by absentee ballot, please plan to do so by Thursday, November 3, 2011. Due to NEW legislation, the Town Clerk's Office will NOT be conducting absentee voting after 5:00pm on Thursday November 3, 2011.

You will **NOT** be able to absentee vote on Friday, November 4, 2011 and/or Monday November 7, 2011. Absentee ballots are ONLY available until November 3, 2011 during normal business hours.

Dog Licenses are mandated by the state and are required on a yearly basis. 2012 Dog Licenses are available now! Current Licenses will expire December 31st and must be renewed before January 31st 2012, after which \$25. Late is applied. You can renew your dog for 2012 by mail, in the office during normal business hours or online at the following web
