### **Old Alfred Road Sidewalk/Drainage Design Project**

The Town of Waterboro will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, May 22 at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Hall Conference Room of the Board of Selectmen. The purpose is to present information and solicit public input on the design of a sidewalk on Old Alfred Road running generally from the entrance of the Middle School to the Friendship Park Area. Representatives of the Town and Wright-Pierce, the Town's consulting design engineer, will be present to answer questions. All interested persons are invited to attend.

This project is funded through the MaineDOT's Quality Community Program to improve pedestrian safety in the neighborhoods near the Middle School and Friendship Park. It is part of the Town's overall goal of improving the safety and walkability along Old Alfred Road and the future growth of the Village of Center Waterboro, in particular for children walking to and from school.
