

Senate Candidates Forum in York County

The “12-Town Group” in York County, an association of a dozen towns and cities whose officials meet regularly to discuss matters of importance to local government, invites the general public to attend the Senate candidates’ forum to be held on:

All 11 individuals in the York County area running to be a State Senator have been invited to participate.

The 12 towns include Acton, Alfred, Buxton, Dayton, Hollis, Limerick, Lyman, Newfield, Parsonsfield, Sanford, Shapleigh and Waterboro. The municipal officers from the Town of Limington have also been invited to participate at the request of one of the candidates.

During the first part of the forum, questions important to local government officials will be posed to the candidates on a number of issues ranging from municipal revenue sharing, school funding, tax policy, road and bridge infrastructure funding and cooperative efforts, and the overall relationship between state and local governments.

After a set of questions related to local government have been asked and answered, an opportunity will be provided so that questions on any other topics important to York County residents can be posed to the candidates from the floor.
