2016 Summer Day Camp FAQ

When and where does camp take place?

Camp begins on June 27 and ends August 5. This year it will be held at Waterboro Elementary School.

Will my child get swim lessons?

Swim space is **limited**, the **first 50 campers enrolled for the full 6 weeks** will receive Red Cross Learn to Swim lessons **included in their tuition**. We are also covering the cost of transporting the campers to Lake Arrowhead's indoor pool.

Where do I drop off and pick up campers?

Drop off and pick up at Waterboro Elementary School. When entering the building, please sign your child into the appropriate age group.

What time does camp begin and end each day?

Before Care begins at 6am, camp starts at 8am each morning with organized free time until 8:45am. Campers break up into their individual age groups after that. Camp ends at 4pm. Make arrangements to have your camper picked up by 4pm or take advantage of our Before/After Care Program.

Can I pick my child up earlier?

You may pick your child up prior to 4:00. Please talk with your child's counselor in the morning so that they can make the needed arrangements.

Is breakfast and/or lunch provided, and when do campers eat?

Both meals are provided through the Federal Feeding Program Grant that RSU #57 received again this year! Breakfast will be served between 7:30-8:30am and lunch will be served between 11:30-12:30pm. Copies of the menu will be available at camp. On field trip days campers will receive a bagged lunch. Please send your child with at least two healthy snacks and beverages; we take two snack breaks each day.

Do I need to call if my child cannot attend camp?

You do not need to call. By not signing in, we are alerted to your child not being present that day. However, if you arrive late, make certain to speak with a counselor or the camp director. On field trip days it's important to be on time.

Can my child go home with friends?

Only those adults listed on your registration form as authorized to pick up your child may sign them out, please plan accordingly.

Is bug spray and/or sun block available at camp?

Both items are available at camp, however, we encourage parents to apply sun block on their children prior to drop off.
