at the Intersect of Route 5 & Old Alfred Road



## Rule Page:

**Public Skating Hours: 7:00am-10:00pm Daily**

**Hockey Games with Sticks and Pucks allowed on the following days & times:**

**Monday, Tuesday & Thursday 7pm – 10pm & Sunday 7am –9am & 7pm –10pm**

**Except for times listed, sticks and pucks are not permitted when any public skaters are on the ice. *Pucks are not to elevate off the ice.***

**Please respect the "CLOSED FOR MAINTENANCE" signs when up for protection of the Rink, Ice and YOU!**

***The use of this facility is at your own risk.***

**This is a drug, alcohol, & smoke free zone.**

**The ice rink is a natural rink that is dependent on weather conditions for ice quality.**

**The rink is designed for recreational skating only and is not maintained at professional or competitive skating standards.**

**A minimum of 72 hours of constant temperatures of 15° or below is necessary before the ice-making process may begin.**

***Ice skating season is December 20th - March 1st , weather permitting.***

**Please observe the following rules so that everyone can enjoy the rink:**

- ~ No skate attendant on duty.
- ~ For emergencies call 911. (Address: 6 Old Alfred Road—Carle’s Corner Ice Rink)
- ~ The Town of Waterboro, Waterboro Historical Society, & Waterboro Parks & Recreation Department does not assume responsibility for injury or for any loss, theft or damage to personal items.
- ~ Users are strongly encouraged to wear helmets and other protective gear.
- ~ Children ages 10 and younger must be supervised by an adult.
- ~ Please enter and exit from the designated ramp area
- ~ Skates must be worn on rink. Guests without ice skates are not permitted on the ice rink.
- ~ No loitering or use of the rink by persons without skates.
- ~ Pucks are not to elevate off the ice.

*Except for times listed, sticks and pucks are not permitted when public skaters are on the ice.*

- ~ Protective gear such as hockey helmets, throat guards, hockey gloves and shin guards are highly recommended.
- ~ No Pets allowed.
- ~ No objects, food or drink allowed on ice.
- ~ No cross-skating or other skating that interferes with general skating.
- ~ General skating is counter clockwise around the rink.
- ~ No speed-skating.
- ~ No games are permitted that will interfere with other skaters.
- ~ Keep the rink tidy. Put your litter in the trash cans provided.
- ~ After skating, please scrape & clear ice of shavings with shovels provided.
- ~ Absolutely NO smoking on property.
- ~ Absolutely NO intoxicating beverages permitted at the skating rink.
- ~ Be considerate of noise levels.
- ~ Do not use foul or offensive language.
- ~ Do not fight or play roughly inside the rink surface.
- ~ Throwing snowballs or any objects onto ice is prohibited.
- ~ No trespassing when rink is closed.
