## ***SEEKING APPLICANTS***

The Waterboro Board of Selectmen, Town Administrator and Town Planner are encouraging residents of Waterboro to become actively involved in the updating of the Town's Comprehensive Plan. Several initial discussions regarding the formation of a new 2020 Comprehensive Plan Oversight Committee have been held and the Board is encouraging interested citizens, businesspeople, elders and young visionaries to join in the master planning process. Citizens wishing to be engaged in a very progressive and proactive workgroup that will be delineating major priorities and action plans for the Town, please stop by Town Hall and fill out an application for committee membership. Applications will be accepted until **April 26, 2010** with hopeful appointments to the 2020 Comprehensive Plan Oversight Committee occurring in May 2010.

A series of visioning sessions will be facilitated by the Town Planner during the summer months. These sessions will gather ideas and help to establish both short and long term priorities for the Town of Waterboro. The creation of the new comprehensive plan will be approximately a two year process and involve a large group of stakeholders and interest groups. New plan elements dealing with economic development initiatives, village and tourism planning, capital improvement planning, updated census data, cultural enhancements and infrastructure investment needs are some of the work areas to be studied.
