Line up starts at Town hall and continues back to Roberts Ridge. The route will cross Rt 5 towards Old Alfred Rd and continue to the middle school. He was going to do a budget on how many deputies would be needed for security detail and get back to us. He also asked if they were approached about having a Sheriff's booth at the event and they would very much like to be apart of that. He was also going to look into the parade float safety guidelines so that we can get the parade signup onto the website.
