Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

Minutes from the September 10, 2008 meeting approved by a motion by Ron and 2nd by Dustin and approved 5-0.

To date 22 roads have been inventoried, 35 reports generated and pictures have been taken of some of the top 5 roads. It is the consensus of the committee that drainage is the problem for a lot of these roads. We spend repeatedly spend money over the years to repair the same problems. Proper ditching needs to be done to correctly solve these problems. Fred will be obtaining rough estimates to repair these roads for documentation.

Fred reported that the account for ditching needs to increase and ditching could be categorized as a capital improvement.

Dustin brought to the attention that some of the mileage does not coincide and he suggested checking the east side section of roads.

Traffic Counter: Frank is in the process of finding out if it is useable. Dustin read somewhere that Shapleigh had one donated to them. Dustin and Fred will check around to see if we can borrow one.

Tammy Jo reported that she has a name of a person from Maine Soil & Water Conservation in Augusta that may be able to come look at McLucas Road.
