

**Road Review Committee

Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM

Motion to approve the minutes from 3/11/09 by a motion by Ron 2nd by Jim approved 6-0.

Tammy Jo addressed the committee regarding the LD974 bill that is in front of the Legislature and how it could impact the town. This bill could result in a loss of \$250,000.00 in 2009/2010 fiscal year and approx. half a million dollars for the 2011/2012 fiscal year. This bill could seriously impact the town in the very near future and could impact the road projects.

Jon reported that during last weeks heavy rain, the only road that was had flooding was New Dam Road. The flooding problems was due to the culverts. Ron reported that he cleaned out a culvert on Ossippee Hill Road.

Fred reported that he has picked up a lot of trash along side the roads.

Dustin & Jim evaluated Townhouse Road for RSMS.

The Committee needs to have a side project that is shovel ready in case a grant comes along last minute like it did this past year

Questionable Road List: We will be submitting our recommendations for Chadbourne Ridge Rd. to the Selectmen once we get accurate mileage of the road. Fred will do the mileage count. Ossippee Hill Road to be addressed at our meeting next month.

Old Alfred Road - Dustin has walked the road and has taken measurements every 10 feet. Hemlock Ave., Hannah Dr., Oak Lane, Pleasant Drive to be addressed at our next meeting.

Ditching Plan: We should start with our priority areas first.

Green Acres Court: A letter was drafted up from the Committee with our recommendations and was given to the Planning Board.

Roads Manual: The 2004 from MMA is the latest edition and this is the version that the committee will be using going forward.
