

**Road Review Committee
Meeting
January 13, 2010**

Members present: James Gendron, Jon Tufts, Roger Macomber, Ron Perro, Fred Fay and Tammy Jo Girard and Committee Secretary Nancy Roberge. Also Present: Representative Joe Wagner, Tom Ursia, and Dan Stewart from MDOT (Dan.Stewart@maine.gov)

Meeting called to order at 6:05 PM.

Motion to approve the December 16, 2009 Minutes by Roger 2nd by Ron approved 4-0.

Dan Stewart from MDOT did a presentation on the sidewalk grant that Waterboro will be applying for. We should contact the CDBG to see if Waterboro qualifies for any rural programs. The application process is open every 2 years and is opening March 2010 and the estimated deadline is June or July 1st and grants are awarded in Spring 2011. We can apply for all the programs every 2 years.

Questions we had - Answered:

- Will need to do a site walk with an engineer to determine catch basins and Dan Stewart can help us with that.
- To increase chances of funding for the sidewalk grant, propose 20% match
- At this time, Dan recommends that we not apply for the sidewalk grant on Route 5 and once Rt. 5 is repaired, then we need to push MDOT get side walks at the schools.
- Maintenance & plowing of sidewalks: Once built the Town has to maintain them.
- Shoulders or Sidewalks – With shoulders it would involve road re-construction.

Priority for the sidewalks:

1. Soccer Field @ Friendship Park to School
2. School to Taylor House
3. Taylor House to Town Hall
4. Town House Road to Ossipee Lake

Road Counter:

Is in the budget and will go to Town Meeting in June.

The tree on Old Alfred Road that was reported as a hazard has been cut down. There are a few more trees in town that need to be taken care of.

Fred reported that while working on Deering Ridge Road, he had to call CMP due to trees on the lines. Representative Joe Wagner informed the committee that Tom Depeter is a good contact with Central Maine Power Company.
