

**Road Review Committee
Meeting**

**August 11, 2010
6:00 PM**

Members present: Chairman James Gendron, Jon Tufts, Roger Macomber, Scott Ohman, Fred Fay, Tammy Jo Girard and Committee Secretary Nancy Roberge.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM.

Motion to adjourn the workshops from 7/27/10 and 8/2/10 adjourned on 8/11/10 at 6:00 PM by Jim and 2nd by Jon and approved 4-0.

Motion to approve workshop minutes from 8/2/10 approved by a Motion by Jim and 2nd by Roger and approved 4-0.

It was brought to the attention of the Committee of some drainage issues on Chadbourne Ridge Road. It is in the plan to install curbing to make that water drain off.

The project on Hemlock & Oak have not started yet, but some brush cutting has been completed. Fred indicated that the sides of the road on Hemlock, over the year's residents have been dumping their brush which cannot continue in the future. Once this project is completed, if the residents continue to dump their brush in the wooded area, there will be flooding issues again. Fred Fay and Pam L'Heureux are to meet with FEMA on 8/23/10 regarding a possibility of some FEMA money for this project.

Ditching is being completed on Ossipee Hill Road.

The Committee recommended the need for full scale drawings of roads here in Waterboro. Tammy Jo indicated that the Town has invested some money in the GIS Program and part of that program will eventually include getting full scale maps. The Town is looking for grant money in the future to help subsidize the costs of getting this program functional.

The Committee now has a road counter.

Next Tuesday August 17th at the Selectman's meeting Tom Urisa will be making a presentation on Safe Route to Schools and the Road Review Committee was invited to attend.

Tammy Jo reported that our new Road Review Selectperson will be David Woodsome.

At the next meeting, the Committee should start discussing CIP projects. One project suggested was the existing sidewalks in East Waterboro. Roger indicated that Jefferson, NH is putting in new sidewalks and the cost is \$115.00 per foot. To install one mile of sidewalks @ \$115.00 per foot would cost \$607,200.00.

The next meeting is September 8, 2010 at 6:00 PM.
