

**Road Review Committee
Workshop
With Selectmen**

Members present: Chairman James Gendron, Donald Drew, Doug Foglio, Fred Fay and Committee Secretary Nancy Roberge.

New truck with sander: Doug to seek prices on a Diesel truck with a stainless steel sander. The sander at the Town garage is not being used – should try and trade it in, worth approx. \$4,000 - \$5,000.00.

Tanker: The body is solid aluminum. Right now it is worth money to sell for scrap. It will be worth more money to cut it up then scrap it. Doug to work on it.

Road Commissioner conflict of interest: The Town needs to appoint a Winter Roads Foreman to avoid conflict of interest per the Town attorney. The contract states that the Selectmen can appoint a winter roads foreman of their choosing.

Hamilton Road Bridge: Needs serious work. Road Commissioner to work out a plan to present to the Selectmen and the Road Review Committee.

Equipment Schedule: Needs to be updated. The Road Commissioner will work on this with the the Road Review Committee.

Town Tractor: Possibly share a tractor/excavator with the Transfer Station. Not recommended.

Lights at Ossippe Lake: Doug had reset the timer, then later that day he went by and the lights were messed up again. The electrical box is rotted out.

Crosswalks need to be painted.

Doug brought up an issue that he has been approached by residents on private roads asking for gravel for their roads. The Selectmen stated that due to State Law that cannot be done.

Logan Circle: Fred Fay indicated that he is going to grade that road and he will not bill the Town.

A section of New Dam Road is scheduled to be paved soon. There are some drainage issues and that should be fixed 1st before paving.

The Road Review Committee will be meeting on July 13th at 6:00 PM.
