

MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting, May 10, 1978

Present: Chmn. Daniel McCarthy, Daniel Willett, John Monteith, TC/TC/T Dianne Holden, Jean Chick, Secy. Lydia Jensen, the Press, Rd. Comm. F. Robert Fay, Tom Cole.

Rd. Comm.: In with payroll. Discussion held on work being done on New Dam road at Lake Arrowhead. Fay said that the area being worked on would have to be surfaced before tarring. He said he would advise two coats, but not to be done all in one day to wait a week in between. Bob asked how much had been spent, Willett said approximately \$8,400. with approx. \$3,800. left in the account. Monteith said that should be enough to finish the work and to go ahead to go ahead with it. ~~xxxx~~ if the account was overdrawn an adjustment could be made. Willett said he should find out from F.H. Scott Paving if he could go in right away and tar. Bob said they had a about a day and a half of work to do.

Tom Cole: In to discuss L.A.E. swaps. Asked if Ron Ward was still handling everything. Willett said as far as he knew he was. Cole said he had heard that Ron Ward was all done as of last Friday, working for L.A.E. Cole said he could not find out for sure on this matter but would like to know what would happen in the event that Ward does leave. Willett said he would call Roger Elliott, Town Atty. on the status of Ron Ward. Cole also asked if Ward was expecting to be compensated by the property owners asking for swaps. Willett, Monteith, McCarthy all agreed that it was to be swap for swap, the only /money involved is to be payment of taxes and the \$31.00 deed fee.

Willett said a meeting will be held on the Visual Aesthetics of the Town, regarding junk cars, etc. meaning unsightly debris on persons property. The following committees to attend Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, Conservation Commission, Selectmen and all interested people of the Town. A date to be set later.
