

MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting, May 24, 1978

Present: Chmn. Daniel McCarthy, John Monteith, Daniel Willett,

Ruth Evans.

Rd. Comm. Fay in to discuss the roads, Monteith asked that Bob see that the dump is pushed back and covered with gravel tomorrow. Also to have two speed limit signs on the Ossipee Hill Rd. Fay requested that Monteith order 12 - 10 ft. posts from the Shurtleff Co.

Fay said they were all done working on NewDam Rd, and that it was being tarred.

Roland & Kenneth Pierce: Into request work from the Town, preferably the job of pushing back the dump, as they have recently purchased a small tractor. Monteith said that the Dump work had been more or less divided between Robert Abbott and Glenn Bean, as the Dump has to be covered over with gravel after being pushed back. Pierce said they hadn't any truck to haul gravel with, but, if the Town could use him sometime he would appreciate it. Pierce also said he would let the Town replace the culvert on his property, they had removed, when the water was high, if the Town would place 500 Ft. of culvert in the drainage ditch along his property so he could gain access to $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres he owns on the other side of the ditch. Monteith said they would discuss this and get back to him.

Ruth Evans: Mrs. Evans asked about back taxes she owes on her Lake Arrowhead property and to check on the matures lein. Monteith explained the situation and ~~xx~~ Mr. Evans said she would be in to pay the Treasurer the amount owed.

Mrs. Jensen: Mrs. Jensen informed the Selectmen that Ron Ward is swapping only what he considers unbuildable and illegal lots at Lake Arrowhead. Also he is accepting soil tests from a Buxton Soil Analyst and turning down all others.

The meeting with the Town Committee's and interested Townspeople on Cleaning up Waterboro, Junk Yards, etc., is to be held June 7.

Monteith said he would place an order at Frost Mimo Co. for reduced Town Maps.

Monteith said he had talked to a man from D.O.T. about the Brock Bridge on the West Rd. and was told that a hearing will be held in July and the "Bridge Act" will be explained. Monteith told him that they had raised equal to 6 Units at the Annual Town Meeting and hoped to bring the Road up to Specs. D.O.T. to make the road 30 Ft. wide and may put in a large culvert like the one they put in, in Hollis. Selectmen agreed they hoped it would be built like Hollis.

A Moderator will be needed for June 13th. Primary-- Frank Goodwin's name was mentioned and he is to be asked.

Warrant # 10 signed.

Appointment papers for several committees were signed.
