Selectmen's Meeting, July 26, 1978

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, F.R. Fay, Rd. Comm. Jean Chick, Secy. The Press: Lydia Jensen, Ruth Evans.

Rd. Comm: Fay, into discuss tarring of roads. He said he and Frank Scott rode around Town to check out the roads, New Dam. Silas Brown, McConkey, Hamilton, Pearl St., Carrie Beans, Brick House. The Selectmen told him they had about enough money left in the account for 8 miles of Seal Coat.

Willett told Fay to pick out roads he thought needed tar.

Selectman Fay. had made a list of roads needing tar with the Rd. Comm., the total list would be approx. $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

Monteith told Fay that the Town had approx. \$1,000. snowmobile money reimbursed from the State, that he should have a talk with Larry Chase, Pres. of the Snowmobile Club and the Fire Chief.

Fay told Selectmen a bill would be on the warrant for Hollis Rd. Comm. for \$ 00. for tarring the end of Pole Line road up over the hill by the Waterboro line.

Tom Cole: In about Lot swaps at Lake Arrowhead. He said that Ron Ward would be all done working for L.A. as of Aug. 5,. he said Mr. Otto may be doing the swaps from Phila. Cole said he would like to make the swaps, as he is Manager for L.A. Comm. Willett said he doubted if that would be possible. Willett said that he told Peter Plumb Atty. for L.A. that the Town would take care of the swaps. Cole offered any help he could give in this matter.

Letters: John Fallon explaining the mix-up of a carbon copy of the July 13th letter being sent to F. Robert Fay by mistake, Waterboro Patent Corp. requesting a meeting with a representative from their Corp. regarding valuation of the property.
