Selectmen's Meeting, Aug. 9, 1978

Mrs. D'Entremont: In to see Selectmen concerning the Stuart Property across Rte. 5 from her property on Ossipee Lake. Mr. Stuart has his property up for sale, it had until recently housed "Mr. Transmission", an Auto Repair Shop. Mrs. D'E. asked if the Selectmen could prevent another business from coming in there. She stated that it was very annoying with the noise (Sunday Mornings) and trucks parked in an undersized parking lot, forcing people to park their vehicles on the sides of the road and in her driveway.
