Selectmen's Meeting, May 8, 1979

Willis Lord, Rd. Comm: Reported that the Road Review Comm. had reviewed two sites--"Sawmill Acres" and "Brookside Estates", copies of the minutes of the meeting to be sent to all members.

Snowplowing Contract discussed a possibility that the Town may be split up into two sections and be put out to bid.

Lord was asked to check on the Dump and that the necessary work be done to comply with the State Forrestry.

Selectmen announced that bids would go out on Seal Coat & Tar, to be opened May 22, at their regular meeting.

Larry Whitehouse: In to discuss land in No. Waterboro located on Garland Hill Rd. that he plans to purchase. He asked if the road would be plowed and maintained. Both the Selectmen and Rd. Comm. assured him that it would be, but that it would no doubt be last on the plowing list, as it ~~is~~ is so far out. Rd. Comm. asked Whitehouse that he inform the Town if he does purchase the land so that his crew can cut brush along side the road.

Darling said he would be glad to serve as a Constable and that he would also Chair a meeting held at a future date with all prospective appointees. He was also made aware of some of the trouble spots in Town.

Selectmen Fay called the Town Office in Hollis to inquire about the Hollis Plumbing Inspector covering for Richard Meggison while he is out of Town for a week. He will get in touch with Robert Neal as soon as possible. Fay discussed the possibility of the Waterboro Jaycee's holding a Rabies Clinic.

Chn. Monteith said that he had talked to Ronald Findlay, Pres. of the Sanford Savings and Loan Assos. regarding a loan to the Town on the addition to the present Town House as per Art. #22 voted in at the Annual Town Meeting in March, 1979. Findlay assured Monteith that the Town would receive a letter on this shortly.
