Monteith opened the meeting, explaining the meeting held April 28th. on Solid Waste, five Towns were represented plus several interested citizens. He said that the Town was in hopes of cutting costs by all going into gether. Selectman Fay asked how the group present tonight felt about Landfill versus Incineration. Lord and Rollins stated they were against Landfill operations.

Monteith mentioned the grey areas in Town were property owners have several junk cars in their yards. He said that some would be getting registered mail on cleaning up. If the clean up was not done then the Selectmen would call in The State .

Roy Darling stated that the Z.B.A. have sent Mr. Fallon representative of the Ireus Co. a letter giving the Board's decision to go with the Planning Board and that Ireus Co. would have to follow proper procedure to have a subdivision on his property of Deering Ridge Rd.

Willis Lord said that the lumber is being cut for the construction of a Salt Shed from trees that he had cut along Town ways. The Planning Board, Selectmen and Rd. Comm. will hold a onsite inspection of the location of the Shed.

Lord reported on the progress of reconstruction of Pound Hill on Ossipee Hill Rd. He added that all roads had been graded, he did say that several boys on Mini Bikes had given him some trouble on the Ossipee Hill Rd. That he had reported to Chauncey and Chauncey would talk to the boys.

Linwood Rollins: Commented that he felt the Town would get at least 50% more value out of the road work by getting it done so early with the advantage of having it packed down before cold weather.

Lord stated that the Dump work had been done and that the Town was not in violation at this time.

Gardner: Gave a report on the Rd. Review Comm. he said that the Committee have reviewed the Saw Mill Acres Rds. and Brookside Subdivision Rds. He also reported that he and the C.E.O. Caldwell have visited the Durgin property on the Robert Ridge Rd. and found that some soils tests had been taken. Gardner said that Cameron had blocked some of the Old School House Rd. with piles of dirt.

Lord reported that Melvin Brackett owner of the Saw Mill Development had mentioned to him that he wished to deed a 25 ft. spand along the Mill Pond.

Judith Carl: Gave a report on the Line Budget for S.A.D.#57. Each Town will have their own informational meeting, Waterboro's will be held on May 31, 7:30 p.m. Town House.
