

MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting, May 22, 1979

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay,
Willis Lord, Rd. Comm. TC/TC/T Dianne Holden, Jean Chick

Rd. Comm. Lord: In with payroll. Discussed the road conditions and the use of a wood chipper the Town had rented. He said that he had talked with Hickey and Michaud about work that would have to be done on the Clark's Bridge Rd. in by Thyng's Mills. They had both agreed to help all they could with cutting brush along the sides and also would use a dozer on the road. Lord said the road would need about 4 culverts one 15" and 3 12".

Seal Coat & Tar Bids opened, the Bid going to F.H.Scott Paving. Other bids received were from Warren Bros.

F.H.Scott Paving Bid:

New Work 22 feet wide MC250 asphalt with sand cover. \$10,500.00 per mile.
Sealing with MC800 asphalt with sand cover including sweeping
\$ 2,950.00 per mile.

Warren Bros.

Application of MC250 covered with sand \$11,000.00 per mile.
Application of Mc800 3,200.00 per mile.

Monteith asked Lord if he would see that the end of Gary Pennell's drive got some patch work done on it as it was torn up some by the snowplow this past winter.

The closing off of the corner of the Dump was discussed.

It was decided to pay Cushings, Brocks and Abbott \$100. each for signing off the property for the construction of the Bridge over Brock's Brook.

Monteith said the Extension Group had contacted him and asked if they could plant shrubs in the triangle in Center Waterboro. It was discussed and decided that this could not be done because of visual problems for Motorists.

David Johnson: In to discuss the projects of the Youth & Recreation Council.

Willis Lord was asked if he could suggest to them how much lime and fertilizer they would need for the Little League Baseball Diamond. Lord told them to order 1 ton of lime and $\frac{1}{2}$ ton fertilizer 5-20-20. He also ~~xx~~ told them that lumber from the building behind the Town House could be used to build a pump house. It was decided that Bob Fay would hire Jim Earl to build a pump house and to purchase a pump and tank. Lord said that he would seed, lime and fertilize the ball diamond.

Willetts asked Lord about snowplowing the new school building in E. Waterboro. He said Lyman would not plow their new school. He said that he did tell the Board of Directors the Town of Waterboro would plow out the circle, one pass. Monteith said if they do plow that they should be able to use the Gym for Town Meeting at no cost, and also the ball fields. He said that Willis should talk to Bob Abbott on this matter.

It was decided that a Victualaer's License hearing would be held at the Town Office, June 12, 7:30 p.m. and that the License fee would be \$10.00.

Monteith asked that the grass in the Cemetery behind the Town House and the grass at the triangle at Center Waterboro be mowed before Memorial Day.
