Selectmen's Meeting

June 12, 1979

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick, Willis Lord.

"Issuance of Victualers or Tavernkeepers Licenses."

Opened by Chm. Monteith at 7:40 p.m.

Present for Licenses:

Mrs. T. Garnett for Garnett's Variety, Martha Cognato for Tony's Sub Shop, Ernest Baker for Sun & Sands Restaurant, Merrill Pazolt for Merrills Country Store. Willett moved and the vote was unanimous to issue licenses to all the above. Also licenses issued to Graves General Store and Peppercorn Rest., representatives to Graves & Peppercorn, unable to attend.

8:10 p.m. Michelle Tatusko representing "The Store" requesting a Victualers License. Monteith asked Ms. Tatusko if "The Store" had a Sales Tax number, she replied that she did not know. Monteith explained that what he was going to say did not pertain to Ms. Tatusko, but to the establishment. That his views on issuance of the license was from prior actions of the previous establishment "The Sawmill Rest." The Sawmill Rest had been issued a Restaurant, Beer, Liquor and Dance license. The Selectmen had received several complains and had had Mr. & Mrs. Tatusko in to talk with them on the matter, but they still continued to receive complains. Monteith said on the basis of past experiences he would have to vote against issuing The Store a Victualers License. Selectmen Fay said he had no objections to issuance of a food license. Selectmen Willett said he felt as Chmn. Monteith and voted against issuing the license. Monteith said that if Mr. Tatusko wished he could call the Selectmen before 10:30 p.m. tonight or come in or call and talk with them any Tuesday night.

Willis Lord: In with Rd. Comm. payroll. Discussion held on roads. Monteith stated that the Dump looked good and that Howard Stone Dump Attendant was doing a good job. Willie to talk to Clint Wakefield about cable over the entry going to the base of the Town Dump. Lord said he had to call C.M.P. to move poles for grading roads.
