June 26, 1979

Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

Thomas Cole: In to talk with Chmn. Monteith requesting a meeting with the Selectmen. Meeting to include Board of Director's of L.A. Comm. and possibly Limerick Selectmen. Cole also reminded Monteith that the recreational facilities of L.A. were available to the Youth Council of Waterboro.

Two dozen No Parking signs to be ordered.

Constable mileage to go from .12 to .15 per mile.

Henry Knight's house fire discussed and the possibility of condemning the remains of the house.

Fire Chief's pay discussed as Richard Eugley had received payment for the full year, Monteith said that this would be up to the Dept. to pay Babe Morrill for his services, as next in Line to be Chief. This would be an internal thing for the Fire Dept. to decide and use their appropriation to cover costs.

Victualer's License Meeting:

Michael Tatusko and Ernest Shufelt in to request a License. Chmn. Monteith opened the meeting by reading the Notice. Monteith again explained his views and reasons for voting against issuance, based on past experiences, with Mr. Tatusko as Prop. of the Sawmill Restaurant. Selectman Fay, stated his vote would be the same as the first meeting (yes). Mrs. Holden abstained. Mr. Shufelt said he felt he and Mr. Tatusko were being used unfairly, by going on past experiences, and both agreed that they would post bond and sign a letter stating that they would not request an entertainment license in the future. Monteith told them he would call the Town Atty. on the bond and for them to get their paper work ready and meet with the full Board at a later date.

Shufelt and Tatusko left hurriedly, stating that they would seek a restraining order and go to court.

Solid Waste Disposal:Monteith said that Portland Press Herald had an item in the paper today that the Legislature had turned down everything but the Governor would sign an allocation of \$500,000. to help Town's on approved sites on a 50/50 basis.

Dianne said she had had an inquiry on taxes due for 1975,76,77 on Lot 1512 and this lot is listed on the deed from Peter Plumb's office conveying it to the Town. Monteith told her to tell the inquirer ,if he callx back that he should contact David Fisher, Trustee,L.A.E.
