Selectmen's meeting

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Willis Lord, Jean Chick

Notice was posted Aug. 28th., requesting bids to sell the small wooden structure adjacent to the Town Hall. No bids were received.

Selectmen Fay, discussed the electrical work for the building at the Ballfield, with the other two Selectmen it was agreed to hire a licensed electrician to do the project.

Victualers Meeting for Howard Doe-----

The meeting opened by Chmn. Monteith, Mr. Doe wishes to open a Coffee Shop on Rte. 202 in So. Waterboro. Doe stated that he planned to be open from 5am. to 2 pm., to serve light breakfast until 10 am., then to sell coffee and baked goods until 2pm. Selectmen asked if he would be using the same Well and Septic system as the former Sawmill Rest. He said the Well would be shared, but he has his own septic system, which he believed to be a 750 gal. tank, that he would not have a public toilet that it would be used only by employees. He will be using the parking lot between his Coffee Shop and the Sawmill Rest. Doe said he planned to have seating for 20 people.

Chmn. Monteith said he would require a diagram of the Septic System stating the distances and locations of the Brook and buildings, etc.

Selectman Willett moved that a Victualers License be granted with conditions that shall be noted on the license that there would be "no public use of toilets". The license not to be issued until this office receives a sketch of the Septic System.
