Selectmen's Meeting

Sept. 11, 1979

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick, Willis Lord

Mr. & Mrs. Robert Jarvis, into meet with the Planning Board, they were advised to return tomorrow night as the Planning Board meets every second Wednesday and fourth Thursday.

Tom Cole: In to see if Selectmen had heard anything from Atty. Peter Plumb on the swapping of Lake Arrowhead lots. He said the Atty. General would be getting involved. Cole commented on the roads and said that the Ledgemere Bridge needed repairs, that some of the planks in the middle of the bridge needed to be replaced. Selectmen assured him that the Road Commissioner would see that they were replaced.

Willis Lord: School busing was discussed, Monteith said the School Dept. were welcome to the flashing lights that were at the old Elementary school in So. Waterboro to use at the new school on Rte. 5.

Snow Removal discussed--letter to be sent to SAD#57 requesting list of turn arounds that would need to be plowed.

Monteith said that the Dump looked good after Bob Abbott pushed it back and covered it with gravel, the cost being \$75.00, he felt this should be done every other Thursday. Also Stoney to be asked to cut down on burning.

Lord said that he would call Robert Quinn and Lawrence Morrill, Acting Fire Chief, to discuss spending of monies reimbursed by the State on the Fire Lanes.

Salt Shed discussed, Lord said the floor 3" thick would cost \$1,320.

Lord said he would remove the lumber from the small building behind the Town House.

Lord said he believed it would take at least another \$5,000. to finish the Hickey Road. He asked if the money had come in for the Town wood he had sold, Dianne said that she hadn't received any, he asked that she send bills to Robert Newton and Chandler Holmes.

Robert McAulliffe in and was told that Allen Jordan, Clerk of the works for the addition to the Town House would set down with him and go over some minor changes in order to cut costs.

Snow Removal Contract holder Robert Abbott to be sent a letter asking for copies of his hazard and personal injury Insurance policies and also a Bond as the present one expires as of this November. Also letter to state the present total contract being \$20,840.00 and that the Selectmen will be meeting with him to add more roads to the contract.

Ambulance Discussion held by the three Selectmen on payment of the additional \$14,500. for the Ambulance. Monteith said he had received a phone call from Babe Morrill, John Smith and Doug Foglio concerning payment before Oct. 1st. As this was the date set by the Selectmen for payment.

After discussing the matter it was decided that the Ambulance check to be dated Sept. 14th and that the Selectmen request that the Ambulance be put in joint ownership, the Waterboro Fire Department and the Town of Waterboro.
