Meeting opened with comments from Chmn. Monteith, he remarked on the Addition to the Town House, which he said Allen Jordan will be the ?Town's Clerk of the Works. He said also that the Baseball diamond should be finished within a week and a half by Cole's Greenhouse Co. A discussion was held on the School busing for the new Elementary School on Rte.5. The Selectmen have not been involved as yet, that the SAD Director's were handling it , but the Selectmen have attended meetings, of the Director's when busing was discussed. Monteith said the tax money was coming in good and that the last day to get discount would be Oct.1st.

Selectmen Fay announced the Waterboro Patent Co. was not employing a night watchman between the hours of 3a.m. and 7 a.m. and that he had called on Roland Benton and was assured that there was no danger at the plant as the Degreasing Plant was not running and acids were not being used like they use to be. It was suggested that the Fire Chief check it out.

Chauncey Gerry announced that the Conservation Comm. would hopefully start a program to provide trips for school children and that Les Leighton had donated his bus to be used on such trips. He said also that they hoped to have a place plowed off for skating on Ossippee Lake. He said they had been attending Dump Meetings for Solid waste Disposal. The next meeting to be held in Hollis, Sept.27th. He attended the meeting with the Selectmen and Stu Gannett on the expansion of Mr. Gannett's business on Rte.5.

ZBA: Williams asked how C.E.O. Caldwell had made out with the Ronald Dyer violation , concerning the placement of a mobilehome on the Dyer property with out the necessary permits. Planning Bd.: A lengthy discussion was held on meetings held with representatives from SAD#57 on fencing etc. for the new school on Rte.5. Busing was touch upon and copies of minutes from Planning Board ~~xxxxxx~~ meetings were made and given to School Director, Willis Lord to make it possible for him to discuss the situation at the Board meeting tomorrow night. Jim Hamilton gave a short review of the two most recent Planning Board meetings.

Fire Dept.: Morrill said that the new Ambulance had been delivered last Friday night and would be registered tomorrow.

Roads: Rd.Comm. Lord gave a run down of roads that had been worked on, and said that the Salt Shed should be completed by next Council Meeting . It has been brought to his attention by two complaints that a Clinton Presby had blocked off the Town road by his property on the Red School House Rd. He said he would check this out and have the fence removed. He has had several requests to place Slow, Children Playing signs. The present Dump was discussed.
