Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. John Monteith , Robert Fay, Jean Chick

Joseph Stolba: In to talk with Selectmen on a matured tax lien on property now owned by him and liened in the name of the former owner Alexander Burr.

Acting Fire Chief: Lawrence Morrill in with the Fire Dept . Warrant. Monteith asked the status of the Dept's. Ambulance Morrill said that the new Ambulance was in service and the old one had been sold to Goodwin's Mills Fire Dept. and that monies received from the sale had been placed in the Dept. Ambulance Fund account.

Monteith said that he and Selectman Willett had received phone calls from Randy Drowns of "Westwind Acres" development concerning the snow plowing of the roads. Drowns had indicated that Mr. Garland the developer would not be plowing the roads this year. Discussion on this matter to be held when Selectman Willett arrived later in the evening.

Mel Brackett: Mr. Brackett, developer of "Saw Mill Acres" , had submitted an article to be placed on the warrant at Annual Town Meeting in March for the acceptance of the roads in his development. Mr. Brackett had explained to Mrs. Chick the layout of the roads that had been built tp Town specs, inwhich included only the entrance and the circle known as Saw Mill Lane and Mill Pond Drive, but not the extension by Lots 18Q and 18R that leads to the Merton Bean property.
