Chmn Monteith gave Mr. Lord opportunity to speak as Lord had to attend an 8:00 pm. meeting at the High School, pertaining to Transportation. Lord stated that he had cut brush along the New Rd., 48" of the Salt Shed roof had been done plus the floor, that the first load of salt had been delivered to Bean's sand pit. Lord commented on the Birch Acres project being done by D.C. Foglio, that since the State Ref. had been passed on Bridges that the Town should receive monies to help repair the Ledgemere Bridge.

Robert McAuliffe, contractor for the work being done on the Town House reported that the Town House had been moved off the old foundation and that within a week should be placed back on the new foundation and work could be started on the new addition.

Chmn. Monteith reported that the financial acct's looked good and that the Finance Comm. would be meeting next week. That the Town should receive about 80% of the taxes by years end. He announced that two hearing were to be held on Nov. 27th. One on the closing of portions of the Middle Road and the other on spreading of cesspool sludge on J. Hamilton property on Hamilton road.

Monteith commended Brenda Leighton and Bob Fay on the work they preformed on the Bottle Bill.

Selectman Willett, spoke on the Dump proposal being

readied by Land Use Consultants ,Inc. He said the Selectmen hoped to present it to the citizens at Annual Town Meeting March, 1980. Also Willett said they hoped to present a package to other Town's in the area at their Annual Town Meetings. A lengthy discussion was held on the sites and the present Town Dump.

Planning Board member J. Hamilton reported on several matters taken up at the past Planning Bd. meetings.

Assessor Caldwell reported that he was meeting with the Selectmen to review the pricing on the new revaluation.
