

MINUTES

Nov. 27, 1979

Hearing held at 7:30 pm. for closing the section of road from Kenneth Roberts residence to the intersection of the Middle road and the Middle road from the intersection of the Red School House Rd. to Starr King's residence , from Dec. 1, 1979 to April 30, 1980. Hearing opened by Chmn. Monteith explaining that the road was not to be considered closed, but, not plowed for the winter months in order to save the Town money. Approximately 20 in attendance. Several landowners from the designated area spoke on reasons they wanted the road kept open, being fire safety, snow removal from roofs of bldgs. and cutting fire wood. Motion was made by Selectman Willett , not to close the road, seconded by Selectmen Fay. voted, passed.

Hearing held at 7:45 pm. for the utilization of septic tank and cesspool waste and other materials as fertilizer on land identified as Map 2, Lots 14 & 15 and Map 4, Lot 65 on the Waterboro tax maps. The above listed property being listed in James Hamilton's name. Hearing opened by Chmn. Monteith. Approximately 12 people in attendance. Roger Smith speaking in favor of allowing Mr. Hamilton to be able to fertilize with the waste material and all other property owners in the designated area being opposed. Also two letters were received from property owners from Hamilton road area opposing it. The Selectmen agreed after the hearing to deny the request of Mr. Hamilton and a letter to be sent out to Hamilton and land abutters.
