## NOTICE

A public hearing will be held Tuesday, 7:30 pm., Dec. 18, 1979 at the Waterboro Town Office Building on a proposed Ordinance for Winter parking and Removal of snow from private property to streets or roads.

(a) Parking vehicles upon any street or road in the Town of Waterboro between the months of November 1st. and April 1st. is hereby prohibited except in cases of emergency. If a vehicle parked on a Town street or road is obstructing snow removal, it will be hauled away at the owner's expense.

(b) No person shall lay, throw, place or plow or cause to be laid, thrown, placed or plowed, on or into any public street or road, any snow or ice from private property. If in the removal of snow or ice from private property it is necessary to temporarily place snow or ice on any public street or road, such snow or ice shall immediately be removed from the street or road by and at the expense of the person that caused it to be placed thereon. Provided, however, that a person shall lay, throw or place snow in the public streets or roads only immediately prior to the plowing of the streets or roads by the Town. Any person in violation of this article will be subject to a fine of not more than 750.00.
