Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Willis Lord, Jean Chick, Robert McAuliffe, Tom Cole.

Tom Cole: In to discuss the lots at Lake Arrowhead which the Town holds for back taxes. Selectmen assured Mr. Cole that an Article would be placed in the Warrant at Annual Town Meeting asking that the citizens allow the Selectmen authority to negotiate the sale of selected Town owned lots at LAE under appropriate terms and conditions with final approval at a future Town Meeting. The Selectmen did state, however, that if lot is determined unbuildable that fact will not change after the sale of the lot, that they will not swap lots and probably there would be a clause in the papers stating that the lot is determined unbuildable.

Rd. Comm. Lord asked for a listing of any monies spent in the months of Jan., Feb. and March of 1979 for sanding.

The snow plowing contract was discussed. Selectmen agreed that the Town should be split up into two sections.
