The acceptance of any of these roads as Town Roads has to be done sometime in the future by a vote of the people at a Special or Regular Town Meeting.

MINUTES

2/12/80 Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, Dianne Holden, Willis Lord, Constables; Leroy Darling, Chauncey Gerry, Ed Waterhouse.

Constables were called in regarding issuance of gun permits. Darling said he would send out a copy of a form used by the Westbrook Police Dept. for the Selectmen's review and that he felt the Town should have the applicant fill out the form and the Selectman call Augusta for a record check before issuing the permit. Selectmen agreed that they adopt this procedure.

Hearing held on the proposed laying out of Roads; Evergreen Drive, Saw Mill Lane, Mill Pond Drive and Brookside Drive.

Dianne told the Selectmen that she had received a check back because of insuff. funds, that she had collected on a tax lein. Selectmen agreed that in the future, the only checks to be accepted on matured tax leins would be bank checks or certified.
