Chmn. Willett opened the meeting by thanking everyone for their support at Town Meeting. Linwood Rollins noted, at this time that Joe Barth had done an outstanding job as Moderator at Town Meeting. Several other points made by Willett were; that the addition to the Town House was coming along good, a special Town Meeting to be held soon for an appointment to the Board of Directors for SAD 57. The Selectmen are working on setting up the Dump project with Regional Waste, selling the present Office Building and the sale of lots at Lake Arrowhead that are owned by the Town. Willett said that if SAD#57 went computer that the surrounding Towns could possibly make use of the computer with their tax bills.

Linwood Rollins suggested that the Selectmen should be checking the price of hot top, with the parking lot at the Town House in mind. Also the price of Seal Coat & Tar. Willett said that bid letters would be going out to local contractors right away.

Willis Lord mentioned the freeze up problems he has had with the culverts. He stated that monies would have to be spent on the Darling road due to a wash out this past storm. He said he had also received a number of calls with complaints on the snow plowing this past storm in the South Section.

A lengthy discussion held on the School budget with Mr. Lord explaining several points and answering questions.

Chauncey Gerry announced that a Rabies Clinic would be held at the So. Waterboro Fire Barn March 30th.
