Selectmen's Meeting April 8, 1980

Letter to be sent to F.H. Scott Paving accepting bid for Seal Coat & Tar.

Willett asked Dianne to put \$11,275. in a 6 mos. C.D. on the Bldg. Fund and also to call and ask the Bank if the Town is receiving interest on the interest on a \$100,000. C.D. the Town has.

Willett called Rep. Harold Hanson and asked if T.R.I. money would be available Hanson will phone Rd.Comm. Lord when he finds this out.

Douglas Foglio, Rd.Comm. & Selectmen discussed the Plowing Contract for the South Section of Town. Willett said the Selectmen had to have his answer, whether he plans to accept the contract at his bid price or not. Foglio said he also felt that on the West Rd. in front of properties owned by Ron Thyng, Russell Smith & Percy Eugley, manual snow removal would have to be done and extra money would have to be allowed, just as it would on clearing the corner by Tony's Sub Shop. Foglio said he would get back to the Selectmen on this matter on April 15th.
