Selectmen's Meeting, April 15, 1980

Present: Chmn. Daniel Willett, John Monteith, Jean Chick, Roger Wilson, Douglas Foglio, Linwood Rollins., Tom Cole.

7:30 :Hearing on Liqour License for Roge's Restaurant, opened by Chmn. Willett reading the notice, Monteith questioned the "part Time" checked on the application. Wilson said the meaning being that he wanted to try the operation out for 6 months to see if it was going to work out well , then decide if he wanted to file for "Full Time". No objections were voiced. Selectmen to sign the license when Selectman Fay arrives and same to be sent to Mr. Wilson.
