

MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting, June 10/1980

Present: Chmn. Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, John Monteith, Mark Caldwell, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick, Tom Cole. Finance Committee members present: Chmn. Linwood Rollins, Steve Kasprzak, Wade Junkins, Jeannie Grant, James Carll, Anne Gardner.

Finance Committee Meeting: Costs of the Town Hall and parking lot paving were discussed. Questions asked about the changes that were made on the building. Willett, explained that the Selectmen agreed that if they had a project before them like the Town Hall addition and renovation again they would have someone on the job as "Clerk of the Works", full time. He said that Allen Jordan was good but was too busy with other things and some decisions had to be made right away and Mr. Jordan was not available to discuss the changes.

Several accounts were reviewed. Monteith said that the Rd. Comm. Lord had inquired about seal coating Pound Hill this year or if he should wait and go into Town Meeting for funds to redo the entire area. Discussion. Chmn. Rollins said that he did not feel the Committee could commit themselves at this time, not knowing the overall budget for next year, whether or not they could back the Rd. Comm. and recommend a large amount to be raised for Pound Hill.

County Agencies such as YCCAC and York County Health Services have sent letters to the Selectmen requesting monies. The letters were reviewed by the Committee and the Committee advised the Selectmen to send copies of the letters and Town Meeting Articles and Minutes to Atty. Elliott for his opinion, whether or not to pay these Agencies.

Solid Waste Disposal discussed, Chmn. Willett asked the Committee for their help in compiling data for their use in determining which alternative to take to solve this problem. Surrounding Towns' were discussed as to the different ways they have solved their dumping problems. It was decided that on June 19, 4:15 pm. Land Use Consultants, would present their slides on various alternatives and the Planning Board and Conservation Commission would also be invited to attend. All Finance Committee members present agreed to choose a Town and collect data on this Town's dumping facilities, such as costs usage, etc. Rollins- Lyman, Gardner- Alfred, Kasprzak- Gorham, Junkins- Ogunquit, Grant- Hollis, Carll- Limington.

Mark Caldwell: Selectmen inquired how Mark was coming with the reassessment of the Town. Mark said that he should be ready by July 1st., to send out letters to each tax payer with approximate tax amounts, using a tentative tax rate figure, then he would hold appointments before the actual tax bill is sent out. Willett asked that Mark have 25 or 30 tax cards ready for the Selectmen's review on June 24 th., this to include, residential, seasonal and commercial properties.
