## MINUTES

8/26/80

Present: Chmn. Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, John Monteith, Atty. Roger Elliott, Willis Lord, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

Rd. Comm: Mr. Lord in with payroll. Lord, informed of a complaint received on the road between Sun & Sands Restaurant and Bedard property. Lord said the next time a grader is hired by the Town the problem would be taken care of.

### VICTUALAR'S LICENSE HEARING SAW MILL RESTAURANT

Hearing opened at 8:15 pm. by Chmn. Willett. Approx. 30 in attendance. Robert Hurst, Michael Tatusko's partner representing the Saw Mill Rest. Hurst said plans are to open a "Steak House" with seating capacity of 60. A liquor license to be sort at a later date, as septic system inadequate at the present for a Class A Rest. with a Liquor license. Hurst presented a sketch of the proposed future septic system. Hours of operation to be 11 am. to 9 pm. (to start with) 6 days a week, closed Sunday. Several citizens Mrs. Cognato, Mrs. Munroe, Ed Ross, Alton Abbott and Fred Pierce spoke against the issuance of the Victualar's License, because of past annoyances. Mr. Ross in particular was concerned about the fire hazards, parking, congestion with buses entering and leaving the West Rd. Hurst said the Rte. 202 entrance would be blocked off, entrance only on the West Rd. "Saw Mill" to be license under Friends II Rest. in Sanford, now owned by Hurst & Tatusko also they are leasing the Intowne Rest. in Sanford. Hurst explained Tatusko absence at the hearing, being that Tatusko was having "open house" at the Intowne Rest. Ed Ross, commented on the fact that if Tatusko was really interested in this hearing he should have attended, Ross also asked about the safety of the chimney. Hurst replied that a new chimney would be built and several other repairs made, but did not want to spend the money until Victualers license was obtained.

Selectman Monteith, said he thought with the population of Waterboro, Restaurants and takeouts and Restaurants with Liquor license we have enough to take care of the Town. Dianne Holden asked Hurst if at the present a Bottle Club was being operated on the premises. Hurst reply was, no.

Meeting recessed for 5 minutes for Selectmen to confer with the Town Atty.

Hearing reopened at 9:30 pm.

Ed Ross requested that Tatusko be present to defend his moral character. That this meeting be postponed, until Tatusko could be present.
