Petition:

Andrew Woodsome, Jr., presented a petition to the Selectmen with approximately 200 signatures, the petition read as follows:

We, the undersigned people of the Town of Waterboro, hereby request the Selectmen to hold a special town meeting as soon as possible to vote on the following article:

To request the Selectmen to reconsider using the new valuation for 1980 taxes. The new valuation does not take into account different values in real estate, based on the present zoning regulations and natural resources inventory. Also, there have been so many requests for adjustments that it is inconceivable how these requests can be processed and still allow the 1980 taxes to be issued on a timely basis. Many taxpayers' assessments will be changed as a result of these requests. These changes also affect other pieces of property; and, therefore all the assessments should be reviewed to be sure that everyone has been treated fairly.

The following policies were adopted by the Selectmen for private party use: Person renting hall would have to hire a constable to be on duty during the time of the function and would also have to pay for custodial fees for clean up.
