### Regular Meeting

Cole said he had spoken with Wood and had been asked for several different things he could not give, such as a Computer run-off and only one Association fee for all lots combine, although several different names will appear on the deeds. Cole asked if the Selectmen planned a Special Town Meeting to accept or reject the submitted proposal. Chmn. Willstt said not until Annual March Town Meeting.

Mark Caldwell, brought in the computer run-off for new figures in the revaluation he had just completed. Mark stayed to discuss this with the Selectmen.
