SELECTMEN'S MEETING:



Willett stated that instead of Mr. Batchelder tying his money up in preparing the property in making it ready to be used, the Selectmen would try to pay the lease money off in two years.

Material sent to Town Atty. for a deed to be drawn up giving Lot 18S Map 20 to the Town of Waterboro from Melvin Brackett as voted at Annual Town Meeting, March 8, 1980.
