MINUTES

Council Meeting:

Tax Anticipation Bids for 1981 to be opened at 8:00 pm, none were received.

Willett opened the meeting stating that the taxes were not coming in as the Selectmen had hoped.

Sel. Fay said that he felt that the D.E.P. were going to turn down the Town on the use of the Batchelder property for dumping of septic tank waste, from statements made by Ron Howe, D.E.P. Representative. However, that the property the Selectmen proposed to purchase for a future dump site for solid waste disposal looked good to the D.E.P. Fay said that some discussion was held on the idea of using the Waterboro Patent Corp. lagoons, if they were first lined with clay as septic dumping lagoons in the winter months.

Law Enforcement: Roy Darling said the Committee would be setting up a meeting with the Selectmen and the newly form County Commissioners members after the first of the year, to see what the Sheriff's Dept. plan to do for the Town for law enforcement before making any recommendations at Annual Town Meeting in March.

Planning Board: Roland Denby said that the Planning Board were still getting the Zoning Ordinance changes together. He said the Board would be having a meeting with the Conservation Comm. to work on the Town owned Lake Arrowhead lots.

Picnic Area: Selectman Fay said that he wanted the Selectmen to meet with the State regarding a charge to the Town for purchase of this property. The State says that if the Town does not purchase the property they will block it off. Fay is hoping the State may change its mind and give the property to the Town.
