1/13/81

Selectmen's Meeting , Regular. 7:30 pm.

Present: Chmn. Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, John Monteith, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

Tom Cole: In to discuss the status of Ledgemere Bridge ,Waterboro-Limerick Line. Chmn. Willett informed the Board and Mr. Cole that he had spoken with a representative from the State and that Federal funding had been cut 60% and monies for Ledgemere Bridge had been lost. Willett said that he planned a meeting with State people on this matter and would notify Mr. Cole to meet with them. Willett said he had to find out the status for the Bridge because of the Warrant for Town Meeting as an article would have to go in to match funds , if they where available.

Mr. Cole asked if Lake Arrowhead Comm. could purchase 5 or 6 tons of salt from the Town. Willett said for him to call the Rd. Comm. Lord on this matter, but felt sure that the Town had salt enough stored in the Town Salt Shed for this purchase to be arranged.

Dump Meeting: Called for 1/23 in the Waterboro Town Hall with Selectmen from area Town's.

Charlot Lake, appointed to Zoning Board of Appeals.

M.M.A. to be called on the amount of Fed. Rev. Sharing the Town would be receiving. (M.M.A. Rep. Steve Gove called on 1/14 and estimated Share for Waterboro is \$54,449.00).

Notices to be sent to Committee Chairpersons, Fire Dept, Supt. of School, etc. for their reports for the Town Report, to be received in this Office before 1/30/81.
