SELECTMEN'S MEETING

1/27/81

Present: Chmn. Daniel Willett, Robert Fay, John Monteith, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

Elizabeth Earle in to request help from the Selectmen on vandalism on her property, she would like the Selectmen to use their influence to seek help from either the State Police or the Sheriff's Dept. Mr. Darling, Constable (present for a ZBA hearing) spoke with Mrs. Earle on the problem and suggested that she call Chauncey Gerry a Constable in Town to help her.

Barbara Ricard: in with a contract for sale of the Old Town Office Bldg. on Old Alfred Road. Chmn. Willett will confer with the Town Atty. before signing the contract.

Fed. Rev. Sharing hearing held with the Finance Committee. Chmn. Rollins asked about the guideline this year, Willett said they would be the same as last year.

Jeff Newick, York County Counseling Services gave the history and services of the Agency which started in 1962. 90 people are on the staff. State funds to be \$630,000. this year. He said anytime the Town wanted to have a program or workshop for a particular problem the Agency would be happy to run one. The Agency at the present time as in the past has requested funding from the County level not the Town's. For the last eight years they have received \$45,000. and have requested \$82,500. this year, they may start requesting funds from municipalities next year.

Wills Lord discussed with the Selectmen the fuel adjustments on the snow plowing contracts and the plowing on Bob Fays Lane, which is depicted on the snow plowing contract map for the Southern Section of Town, as to be plowed.

Selectmen met with the Finance Committee on articles for the Warrant for Town Meeting, March 14th.
